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## URGENT WARNING TO ALL CONVEYANCERS : FRAUDULENT TRANSACTIONS INVOLVING PROVINCIAL LAND

The attention of the KwaZulu-Natal Law Society has been drawn to a series of fraudulent transactions involving State Provincial land which have been registered in the deeds registry in Pietermaritzburg.

The Acting Head of Department: KZN Public Works, has asked the Society to notify all attorneys and conveyancers that the following persons *only* are authorised to dispose of State Provincial land in any manner in terms of the KwaZulu-Natal Land Administration and Immovable Asset Management Act 2014, and to sign conveyancing documents:

- 1. The Member of the Executive Council for Public Works : Mr Ravigasen Ramganathan Pillay; <u>or</u>
- 2. The Acting Head of Department : Mr Thulani Alfred Mdadane.

All conveyancing documentation involving the transfer of State owned land (whether registered in the name of any **provincial government department**, the **Provincial Government of KwaZulu-Natal**, or the **National Government of the Republic of South Africa**), <u>must</u> contain the name of either one or the other of the abovementioned individuals, and must be signed by that person.

<u>Moreover</u>, all attorneys and conveyancers have been advised to confirm the authenticity of all proposed transactions involving land referred to above, by submitting a request for confirmation to the Department of Public Works at the following email address <u>prior to</u> accepting instructions to deal with the transaction:

Attorneys and conveyancers are warned to exercise great diligence and extreme vigilance, and to obtain the requisite confirmation for all transactions involving State owned land – **in addition** to those transactions where State Provincial property has <u>already been transferred to the current registered</u> <u>owner during the last two years</u> – which means checking who the transferror was in every current title deed.
